    - 3.1 **ROAD RESURFACING AT CONNOLLY PARK, BALLYPHEHANE**

‘That Connolly Park be included in the road resurfacing programme and a survey be taken of the condition of the footpath.’

    - 3.2 **DANGEROUS WALL BETWEEN WILLOW COURT/WILLOW DALE**

‘That Cork City Council take immediate action to rectify the dangerous wall between the above Estates and the old Nemo Rangers. This situation has been going on for four years.’

    - 3.3 **INCLUDE CLAREVILLE ESTATE AND LANDSCAPE PARK IN THE ESTATE AND FOOTPATH RENEWAL PROGRAMME**

‘That Clareville Estate and Landscape Park be surveyed and included in the estate and footpath renewal programme.’

3.4 **ROAD WIDENING AT COONEY'S LANE**

‘That Cork City Council dramatically improve and widen Cooney's Lane and the Road on Elm Hill from the junction of Cooney's Lane to Cork Airport Roundabout so as to facilitate the enormous amount of extra traffic that is going to be generated by the large new housing development on Cooney's Lane.’

(Proposer: Cllr. S. O'Callaghan 19/492)

3.5 **SPEED RESTRICTION ON CONNAUGHT AVENUE**

‘That a 30km speed restriction be introduced on Connaught Avenue and connecting roads.’

(Proposer: Cllr. D. Boyle 19/494)

3.6 **REINSTATE FOOTPATH**

‘That Cork City Council reinstate the footpath outside Emoh Ruo, Landscape Park and The Elms, Clareville Estate.’

(Proposer: Cllr. S. Martin 19/168)

3.7 **FOOTPATHS AT PALACEANNE AND KILCOLMAN**

‘(a) That Cork City Council working in tandem with the residents of Palaceanne and Kilcolman look at ways which would allow footpaths to be created at their exits on the South Douglas Road allowing people safe pedestrian access to Douglas or town.  
(b) Funding be identified to locate a green man crossing in this area.’

(Proposer: Cllr. S. Martin 19/198)

3.8 **FOOTPATH ON GEORGE'S QUAY**

‘That this Council examine the footpath along George's Quay. There are a number of paving slabs loose and are a trip hazard.’

(Proposer: F. Kerins 19/509)

4.1 **DOG WALKING AREA/PARK WITHIN TRAMORE VALLEY**

‘That City Council would incorporate a dog walking area/park within Tramore Valley to facilitate people who want to leave their dogs run free and not to be keeping them on a leash constantly.’

4.2 **UPGRADE PLAYGROUND AT BALLYPHEHANE PARK**

‘That the very well used playground at Ballypnehane Park be invested in and upgraded and appropriate security installed given damage done to existing infrastructure which has ruined the playground for genuine users.’
