The Competition

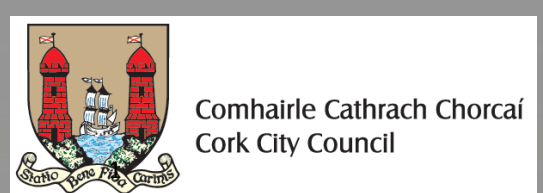

- Prize for the **1st place winner's school:**
 - A visit to the school by a horticulturist, who will advise and carry out planting for biodiversity and cleaner air, in a chosen area of the school.
 - A visit by wildlife expert Jim Wilson, to talk to the students about biodiversity and its importance for clean air.
